

Sports Building

It is proposed to provide new sports facilities. These will enhance existing sports accommodation and provide a betterment of sports provision for both the College and the local community.

This could include a four court sports hall with changing rooms (subject to funding). The hall could also provide the College with increased exam space. Outside of college hours the facilities will allow for community use.

The proposal includes new parking to meet existing and future need for the College and to provide visitor parking for community users of the Sports Hall.



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We have looked at a number of possible locations on the Varndean College site to site a new sports hall. We have discounted development on the main college pitches or on areas where there are already buildings. We have examined four possible locations. Each has advantages and disadvantages:

Location 1	 Large open site which could accommodate the footprint of a sports hall. Possibility to screen the sports hall with planting and bunding 	 Impacts the strategic views from Surrenden Road to the Sea. Unsuitable vehicle access Difficult to secure out of hours Difficult topography Difficult construction access Impacts the open space Negative impact on adjacent neighbours Could impact on slopes and banks with some ecological value Loss of sports pitches
Location 2	 Previously developed site Close proximity to main buildings Little impact on strategic views 	 Site required for teaching space expansion and hut replacement No vehicle access Very difficult for community access No visible street presence
