

# FLYING START TASKS

## GRAPHIC DESIGN

To be completed by your first lesson in September.

### Task 1: Photographs

#### Take 30 photographs

Take 30 photographs of interesting things. You could photograph people, places, objects in and around Brighton or in your own home/garden. You have the freedom to photograph whatever interests you, but you must make sure that your photographs are:

- ✓ VISUALLY EXCITING
- ✓ USE GOOD LIGHTING CONDITIONS
- ✓ IN FOCUS, NOT BLURRY

#### Print your photographs

Print your photographs at approximately 6 by 4 inches (slightly bigger or smaller is perfectly fine). You can use your own printer if you have one, an online printing service or an in-store kiosk in Boots or Jessops.

#### Save your photographs

Save your photographs onto a USB stick or camera phone so that you are ready to transfer them to a computer and edit them in Photoshop for the first project in September.

## Task 2: Collages

### Create 4 collages

Using any materials you have at home, create a set of four abstract collages about any topic you like. It could be about climate change, music, travel... whatever interests you! Your four collages must be small enough to fit onto one A3 page.



You can use images from newspapers and magazines, photographs, drawings, paintings, text printed from a computer or drawn by hand.

### Write an evaluation

Write 100 words evaluating your process of putting together your collages and explaining what your collages are all about. This can be either handwritten or word processed.
