**You should consider A Level Music Technology if you are:**

- Interested in the production of recorded music and want to learn skills to apply to your own recordings
- Interested in the history and theoretical study of popular music and its production
- Comfortable working on long term musical projects and are self motivated and able to work well on your own.

- Learn about the physics and techniques of music production and audio recording
- Complete a portfolio of production work including a Multi-track recording and a creative arrangement to set briefs
- Study all popular music styles from a musical, cultural and technological perspective

**You should have:**

**Standard Advanced Level entry requirements, plus**

- Some basic keyboard ability
- The ability to play a musical instrument to some level
- An interest in, and appreciation of, popular music and technology
- Science GCSE at Grade 4 is also desirable
- Some knowledge of Music Theory is also desirable
