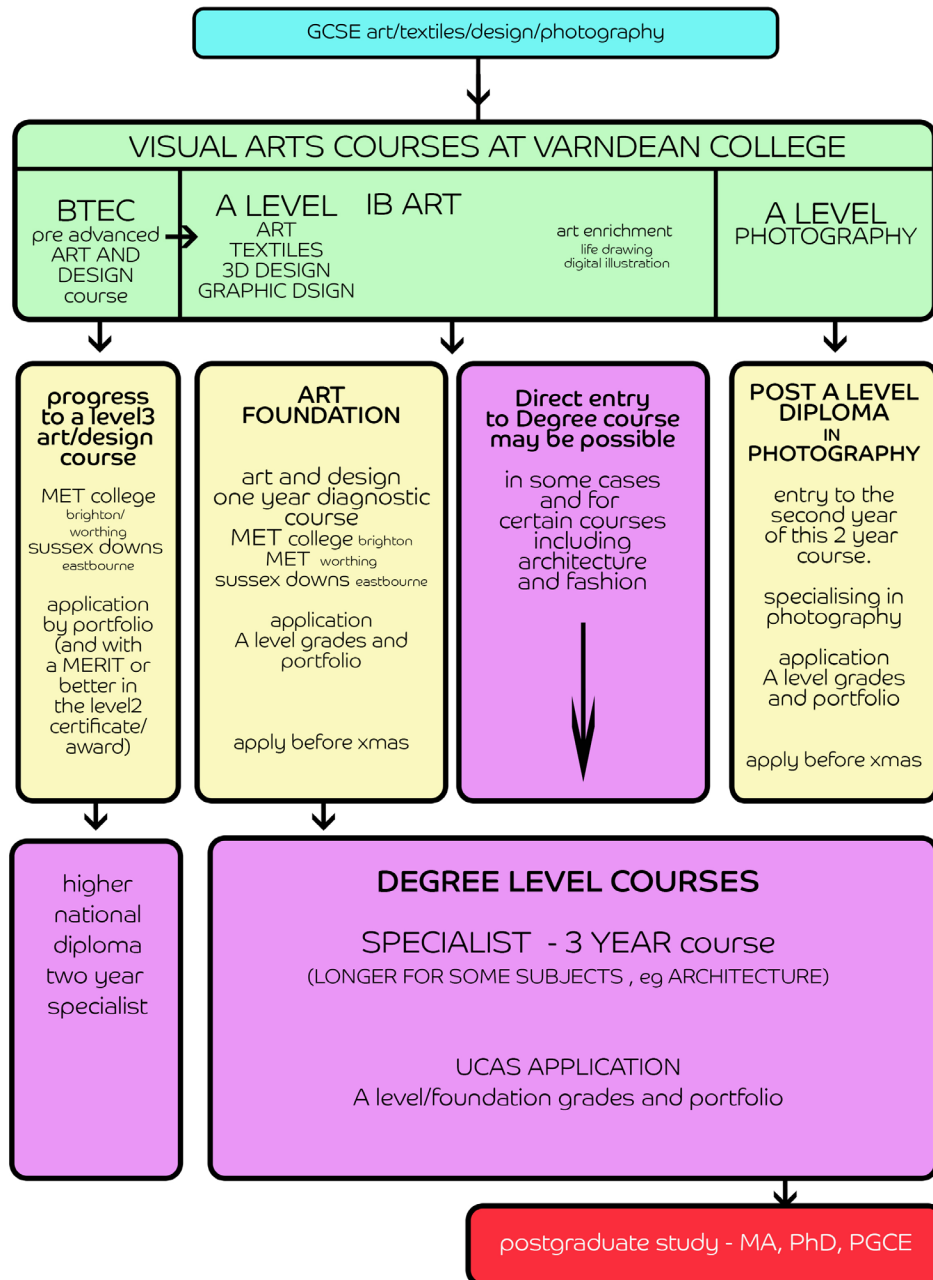

- The Gross Value Added (GVA) of the UK creative industries was estimated to total £91.8bn in 2016*
- Between 2010 and 2016, GVA rose by 44.8 per cent in the creative industries, compared to 22.7 per cent in the economy as a whole during the same period*
- Creative jobs are some of the least likely to be lost to automation.
