

## Entrance Building

A new entrance building in place of 'Rooms 30-31' could create an enhanced pedestrian entrance from Surrenden Road.

This could include a generous entrance foyer, providing a positive first impression of the college.

The location of the entrance building could allow students to disperse in a number of directions and alleviate pressure on circulation in the existing buildings.

The design could incorporate a new café open exclusively to students, providing increased social space and outdoor seating at the heart of the campus.

The new entrance building could enable the consolidation of offices and administration space, allowing old administration spaces to be repurposed for teaching and learning space.


