
## Considering University? Where to get help...

#### **UCAS Timeline**

Students can book an appointment with the Careers Team at any time to receive 1:1 support with decision making





### **UNIVERSITY - What to Consider**

Is there a subject they really want to learn (more) about?

Are they good at self directed study?
Are they ready to 'spread their wings'?
Will they ask for help if they need it?
Does their career plan require a degree?



### **UNIVERSITY - Benefits**

- Dedicated time to explore their subject Stepping stone to further academic/professional qualifications Lifelong friendships/contacts **Exposure to industry relevant cutting edge** research
- On average, earn more when starting work and through working life



### How to Choose a Subject...

Are they open to discussing this with you? Do they actively want or need a gap year? (check universities of interest allow a gap year - this usually depends on subject) Ask universities to send a prospectus - do a 'deselection' exercise together - it's easier to eliminate lots of subjects than pinpoint one What topics fire them up at home?



### How to Choose a Subject...cont.

- Are there any particular modules/units/assignments they have enjoyed more than others?
- Would they want to turn their hobby into a career if they could expand on this idea?
- Even if they are academically able, are they happier being more hands on?
- What do they care about?




### How to Choose a Subject...cont.

Listen to online subject lectures and webinars Use student forums such as 'The Student Room' to hear what other students say **Connect with current university students** through Unibuddy Consider a 'combined' degree Keep options open and choose a general subject & specialise at masters level




### Select up to 5 Courses
