

UKVI Student Visa terms and conditions

When you visit the UK on a sponsored visa, it is essential you understand there are some conditions you must follow while you are here.

The conditions are:

- 1) You must have an INTENTION to study hard on your course.
- 2) You must ATTEND and ENGAGE in all the lessons. Varndean expects a minimum of 95% attendance.
- 3) You must have met all the entry requirements and BE ABLE to understand the lessons; and if you find it hard, to ask for, and accept, help from the college.
- 4) You must LEAVE the UK at the end of your course.
- 5) Your family must have ENOUGH MONEY to pay for the course and your living costs.
- 6) You are not allowed to get paid work while you are in the UK. You may be able to volunteer for a charity, but need to check with the International Office first.
- 7) You must inform the Registry every time your contact details change, which includes mobile phone numbers, home address, UK address.

Note: If you do not follow them, the College is legally responsible as your sponsor, to report you to the UK Government Home Office Department. If this happens you could be sent home early.
